<p>Story Start</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introduce main character • Straight into some action • Shows the reader not tells through speech and powerful verbs • Interests the reader- puts a question in their mind • Follow speech with powerful verb • Indicates the setting • Sentence beginning with a verb- non-finite clause 	<p>Build Up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Time connective to move the story on • Powerful verb to show the reader about the character • Don't include all the details • Speech followed by what the character is doing- use powerful verb • Sub-ordinate clause- as, because, although, until
<p>Climax</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use speech to move the story on • Don't include all the details • Short sentences to build the suspense • Think about what the character is feeling and show it with powerful verbs and speech • Follow speech by what character is doing using powerful verb 	<p>Resolution</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move the story on by changing the scene • Show the characters feelings through speech and powerful verbs • Use brackets for extra information • Subordinate clause • Adverbial phrase- when • Follow speech by saying what the character is doing
<p>Ending</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use speech to have characters comment on what has happened • Show how things have changed from the beginning of the story- character has got his wish
